

**LEHIGH ACRES COMMUNITY COUNCIL MEETING

The meeting was called to order by President, **Rick Anglickis** at 6:05 p.m.

QUORUM: Established with 14 members present.

AGENDA: Under New Business Chuck Edwards asked that the Nickel Sign be added. Linda Saul made a motion and Orville Hall seconded the motion to make the addition. Passed unanimously.

SECRETARY'S REPORT. A motion was made to accept the Secretary's reports for November and December. Passed unanimously.

TREASURER'S REPORT: A motion was made by Diane Turrill and seconded by Linda Saul to accept the Treasurer's report. Passed unanimously.

FIRST VICE PRESIDENT'S REPORT: (Chuck Edwards) Will be editing the web page. Rick talked to Dave Deetscreek and gave him the information available from Joe Mazurkowitz. Dave has obligations to fulfill and will be unable to head the incorporation efforts at this time. Chuck was unable to talk to Damon Shelor regarding incorporation.

SECOND VICE PRESIDENT'S REPORT: (Mo Yasin) Mo arrived late and was unavailable to give his report. A motion was made to table the Second Vice President's report until the February meeting. Motion was made by Chuck and seconded by Bill Martin. Passed unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS: Bill Martin will obtain a letter from one of the Lehigh Acres military organizations to appoint a representative to the Community Council. Chuck has a person in mind for that position and will make contact.

There were no new membership applications, terminations or resignations.

ELECTIONS: President, the nominating committee nominated Chuck Edwards. Diane Turrill, seconded by Linda Saul, nominated Rick Anglickis. A paper ballot was conducted, Chuck Edwards is the President, Rick Anglickis is Chairman of the Board.

First Vice President, the nominating committee nominated Tyler Woodby, there were no nominations from the floor. Tyler Woodby accepted the position.

Second Vice President: The nominating committee nominated Mo Yasin. There were no nominations from the floor, Mo Yasin is the Second Vice President.

Treasurer: The nominating committee nominated Bob Saul to continue as Treasurer. Bob accepted the position.

Secretary: The nominating committee nominated Diane Turrill. Diane declined to run for office. Jane Bell was nominated by Tyler Woodby, seconded by George Kloers, Jane declined the nomination. George Kloers was asked to be Secretary and accepted the position.

Tyler Woodby made a motion to close the nominations and Linda Saul seconded it. Passed unanimously Installation of officers will take place at the February meeting.

NICKEL SIGN: Chuck Edwards reported the tree stump portion on one side of the side was in need of repair. He also suggested putting a sign on the Nickel to announce the repair had been made by the Council. He talked to James Schultz regarding the repair and James agreed to make the repair needed. Chuck agreed to pay for the repair. A motion was made by Tyler Woodby, seconded by DeWitt Green.

Will Bronson asked if a sign stating the Council had made the repair, would that make the Council appear to be responsible for any future repairs. Will also suggested adding a request for "No Littering" signs. Rick Anglickis suggested sending LAMSID a letter regarding the repairs. Chuck Edwards made a motion to send the letter and Bill Martin seconded it. Passed unanimously.

ADOPT A ROAD: The first Adopt a Road clean up was a success with nine bags of trash picked up. A second clean up is planned for March 9th or March 30th at 8:00 a.m. Jane Bell will contact the Lee County Sheriff's Department Day Program Coordinator to ask if community service individuals would be allowed to participate. Jane also suggested contacting the high schools to ask students to participate.

Jane Bell announced the next Relay for Life is scheduled for April 6th at Cypress Lake High School. She will let everyone know the start time.

FOR THE GOOD OF THE ORDER: Will Bronson and Orville Hall spoke about the importance of Martin Luther King Day. Bob Saul reminded everyone to contribute to **FRIENDS OF THE CCOUNCIL**. Yepram Dervahanian has been involved with the school board, attending meetings and is concerned about the half cent sales tax increase, wondering how that money will be spent. He also suggested a major car dealership and a college campus be added to Lehigh Acres. Mo Yasin announced there will be a Town Hall meeting at Veterans Park on February 7th at 4:00 p.m. The topic will be where Lehigh should go. He encouraged everyone that could to attend this important meeting.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:15 p.m.
