AGENDA: Was approved unanimously. There were no public comments.

MINUTES: Mohamed made a motion to approve the minutes, Linda Saul seconded. Approved Unanimously.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Linda Saul made a motion to approve the Treasurer's report, Tyler Woodby seconded. Approved unanimously.

GUEST SPEAKER: Ray Judah spoke on the importance of the Lee County Commissioners to be non-partisan. A web site has been set up for information at leevoteoffreedom.com. Mr. Judah passed out petition forms for signatures from those who felt having non-partisan commissioners to sign. The goal is 30,00 signatures. He reported the PAC's make donations to advertise against candidates they feel won't serve their specific needs and interests.

FIRST VICE PRESIDENT'S REPORT: Tyler Woodby had no report.

SECOND VICE PRESIDENT'S REPORT: Mohamed Yasin reported Starbucks is looking for a Lehigh location.

Charles Edwards reported elections will be held at the January meeting, the nominating committee deferred their report until that meeting.

ARB – the first hearing will be for a corporation that intends to erect a communications tower. Rick Anglickis reminded the members that our responsibility is to vote to improve the projects, not approve the projects.

Mohamed Yasin reported Code Enforcement is investigating the possibility of making vacant lot owners clear a percentage of their lot if it is overgrown and encroaching on a lot with a residence on it. He also reported a petition is needed to limit the fire assessment fees.
